AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

Qualifying score required for all prizes in regular classes

“Dog” means either sex Move-ups will be allowed

Refund of entry fee less \$5.00 will be given to bitches in season with a written notice from the veterinarian. The note must be presented to the trial secretary before the start of judging.

A dark green qualifying score rosette will be given to each dog receiving a qualifying score.

CLASSES OFFERED

Regular obedience classes: Novice class A, Novice class B, Open class A, Open class B, Utility class A, and Utility class B

Regular Rally classes: Rally Novice A, Rally Novice B, Rally Advanced A, Rally Advanced B, Rally Excellent A, Rally Excellent B

Non-regular or optional obedience or rally classes will not be offered.

Jump heights MUST be on both Rally and Obedience entry forms for classes that require jumps—any entry forms missing this information will be considered “incomplete” and sent back. This may result in your entry getting shut out so be sure to include your jump heights!

All classes with jumps will run in ascending order, starting with the 4” dogs.

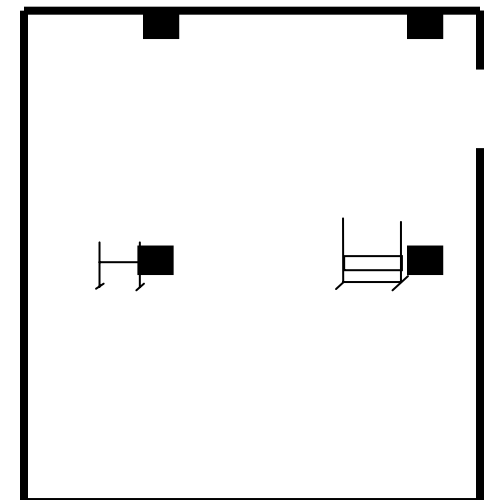
All classes without jumps will run in catalog order.

Important site notice

There are 2' x 2' pillars in our rings! The utility ring must be set up with one jump on the inside of the pillar and one outside the pillar as diagramed to the right.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Telegraph, Telephone, Fax, Email and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms, downloaded and/or photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable.

Mail all entries with fees to Lori A Carver, Trial Secretary 18 Plainfield RD, Cummington, MA 0126. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practicable with identification cards. The person accompanying a dog must show identification before the dog will be received. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within reasonable time please contact the trial secretary.

Make all checks and money orders payable to PCOTC, no credit or debit cards will be accepted for payment. Canadian exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. funds. The trial Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. Tabulate carefully. Due to the cost of processing no refunds \$4.00 and under will be made.

An AKC recording free of .50 first entry only and an AKC Event service fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show, obedience trials or tracking test. An AKC recording fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in any licensed or member club rally trial. All recording and event service fees are paid to the AKC.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance—however the trial secretary will, to the best of his/her ability, separate multiple entries made by one handler.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the event committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and dictates of law enforcement or the owners(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including but not limited to the condition of the facilities or grounds and /or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered to the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry will be made. To find out about any AKC event cancellation call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline 877-252-3229.

Post dated checks, returned checks do not constitute valid entry. The trial secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check of \$40 and entry must then be made with money order only.

An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from refunds for processed duplicate entries and/or any entry canceled prior to the closing date. Every effort will be made to find and return duplicate entries before processing.

Errors on entry forms: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the closing date.

Each Owner and agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at a show is bound by the certification and agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed and submitted the entry form.

As specified in Chapter 12, section 4, of the AKC rules applying to dog shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the show's catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time for judging—the facility will open at 8:30am. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

All dog feces must be picked up, failure to do so will result in a trial committee hearing and excusal from the show grounds without refund of entry fees.
