Denise is a 25 year veteran of training, competing and titling in obedience, schutzhund, tracking, agility, conformation and herding who has earned multiple HITs in obedience and schutzhund along the way. Denise's positive training methods are widely recognized for producing dogs with exceptional attention, accuracy and enthusiasm for their work. Her current competition dogs, "OTCH Raika Schh2 UDXTD" and "Cisu Schh3 UDXTD," routinely score in the high 190s in AKC obedience and high 90s in schutzhund obedience.

Denise does more than teach you to train your dog in specific exercises (in fun, energizing ways!); she teaches you to understand the work from your dog's point of view so you become a problem solver for your dog. She places special emphasis on handler body mechanics and teaches the handler to communicate expectations as the dog learns to self-correct without verbal or leash help. This "body reining" approach results in increased attention and awareness in the dogs as they adjust and respond to subtle handling. She uses NO pain compliance techniques in her training, and she is extremely careful about respecting a dog's emotional make-up as well.
