

REGULATIONS AND ROUTES

REGULATIONS:

- Children and Teenagers are welcome at PCOTC subject to the following guidelines: In any case, and for all classes, instructors reserve the right to ask disruptive children to leave the building and/or require a legal guardian to be present and/or take over training the dog. Children 7 and up may handle dogs in Breed Handling classes but a legal guardian must be present at all times. Children under 9 may come to classes, if supervised outside the training ring by a legal guardian who is not handling the dog. Children 9 to 11 years old may, at the instructor's discretion, participate in class if accompanied, in the training ring, by a legal guardian. Children 12 and over may train their own dog but a legal guardian must be sitting ring-side during class. Children over 16, at the instructor's discretion, may train their dog without a legal guardian present.
- No parking in the lot behind the facility weekdays without a valid handicapped sticker. There is plenty of free parking on the street. After 5:00 PM and on weekends, you may park in the lot.
- Do not let your dog eliminate on a building wall, the sidewalk, cars in the parking lot or our metal deck. The City of White Plains requires that all dog refuse be picked up, with a \$100 fine for each violation. Pooper-scooper bags are available in front of the facility door, and inside the facility, or bring your own. Deposit bags in the metal trash can just outside the entry door. Failure to comply may result in expulsion from class.
- If your dog has an accident inside the facility, it's your responsibility to clean it up, thoroughly and completely. Instructions and supplies for cleanup are provided on the cleaning shelf next to the kitchen.
- Do not linger near the doors, come all the way in the building. Keep your dog on a short leash or crated when it is not working. Dogs other than beginners must remain quietly crated if their owners are otherwise occupied. Excessive barking cannot be tolerated.
- Bitches in season should not attend Family Manners Foundation classes. More advanced dogs, with the instructor's permission, may attend classes provided they are wearing britches or panties.
- Pick up after yourself. Throw trash in the kitchen or garbage cans, and put soda cans in the recycling bin.
- Help with the equipment. Agility students are required to help set up, and take down the equipment, and set the bar heights.
- Wear appropriate shoes for your safety. No heels, sandals, etc.
- Do not throw paper towels, dog waste or sanitary items in the toilets. Dog waste must be put in the metal can on the deck, not in the indoor garbage cans.

FOR ALL LEVELS AND ALL CLASSES:

- If the class you are in is not right for you & your dog, your instructor reserves the right to move you to the level of class that is.
- In any class where dogs are off leash, your dog MUST be able to be collected, or recall to you, in a timely manner. Any dog who holds up the class because he won't come when called will be asked to join an appropriate obedience class.
- All classes should be repeated until the instructor recommends you move to the next level.
- All Agility students are expected to help with equipment; refusal to do so can result in expulsion from class.
- Dogs must be able to remain quietly in their crates while their owners are otherwise occupied.

REGISTRATION:

Class registration is done through the mail or on our website. For mail: please complete the form(s), enclose payment and mail to Registrar, 220 Ferris Ave. White Plains, NY 10603. If sending your application by overnight delivery, make sure to check the signature waiver. If you do not hear otherwise, your class will be held and your enrollment has been accepted. For online registration: See www.TeachRover.com and click "Classes and Registration", then click the "Register Online" box. You will not be admitted if you are not on the instructors' roster. If in doubt, call the above listed phone numbers.

ROUTES:

From the east: I-287 west to exit 6. At the end of the exit make a left onto Orchard St. At the light make a left and the first right onto Westview Avenue, make the second right onto Wardman St. At the end of Wardman, the facility is directly across the street. A right onto Ferris and first driveway on the left will take you to the back of the building where we are located.

From the west: I-287 east to exit 6. At the end of the exit make a right and immediately make the first right onto Westview Avenue, make the second right onto Wardman St. At the end of Wardman, the facility is directly across the street. A right onto Ferris and first driveway on the left will take you to the back of the building where we are located.

From the north: Taconic Parkway or Saw Mill River Parkway south to Bronx River Parkway south. Left onto Fisher Lane, at the light make a right onto North Broadway. At the second light make a right onto Cemetery Rd. Make your first left onto Ferris Av.

From the north: I-684 to I-287 follow from east above.

From the south: Bronx River Parkway north to Exit 21, turn right at the end of the ramp, at the first light make a left onto Bank/Ferris Ave. Continue straight, bear left at the fork, PCOTC is #220 on the left, red brick building—we are located in the back of the building.

From the south: I-87 or Saw Mill River Parkway to I-287 follow from west above.

From the south: Hutchinson River Parkway to I-287 follow from east above.
