Training Agreement/ Liability Waiver

I acknowledge that PCOTC's premises, and the animals, guests, items and activities thereon, pose dangers to people and animals. Such dangers include, by way of example and not limitation, animals that can bite, trip, knock down, and fight, indoor and outdoor surfaces that may be slippery, equipment that can trip, guests and clients who cannot control their dogs, and activities involving my dog(s) and/or other dogs that can result in injury from bites or other causes. Accordingly, I, on behalf of myself, my spouse and minor children, and anyone else whom I bring onto PCOTC's premises, assume the risk of injuries, losses, damages, costs and expenses by any means above described, and other injuries, losses, damages, costs and expenses of every possible cause and description unless inflicted intentionally or recklessly by PCOTC, its Trainers and their agents. If Dog is injured in a dog fight or an accident, gets fleas, ticks or worms, contracts any illness or disease, is lost or stolen, becomes pregnant, or engages in any dangerous, vicious or unwanted behavior, during or after the term of this Agreement, on or off PCOTC's premises, I accept the risk of the same and agree that PCOTC, its Trainers and their agents shall not be held responsible for it or any resulting injuries, losses, damages, costs or expenses.

If any dog I bring to the PCOTC premises causes property damage, or bites or injures any dog, animal or person (including but not limited to PCOTC, its Trainers and their agents), during or after the term of this Agreement, on or off PCOTC's Premises, I agree to pay all resulting losses and damages suffered or incurred by PCOTC, its Trainers and their agents, and to defend and indemnify PCOTC, its Trainers and their agents from any resulting claims, demands, lawsuits, losses, costs or expenses, including attorneys fees.

At PCOTC, its Trainers and/or their agents' sole election, duties hereunder shall terminate if (a) in Trainer's sole judgment Dog is dangerous or vicious to Trainer or any other person or animal, or interferes with the training of other dogs, (b) Client breaches any term or condition of this Agreement, (c) the dogs barking is deemed a disturbance (d) failure to pay the proper amount for the class and/or late fees or (e) an agility student's refusal to help move, set up, or take down agility equipment. Upon termination in accordance with the foregoing, Trainer's duties shall terminate but all other provisions of this Agreement shall continue in full force and effect.

REFUND POLICY: All refunds are subject to a \$25 administrative fee. Refunds/credits will be issued 30 days after the registrar or treasurer receives the request. A full refund will be given to those who provide the registrar notice they are dropping out before classes begin; half tuition credit will be issued for notice given between the first and second weeks of class. After the second, scheduled, week of classes there are no refunds/credits, except where the dog or handler have become incapacitated (unforeseen emergencies only). A note from your Vet or Doctor documenting the injury is required before a credit can be given. Credits must be used within 6 months or are forfeit. PCOTC reserves the right to deny entry/application to classes to any person/dog for any reason.

I will not bring any dog onto the PCOTC premises that: has bitten a person, has pending adjudication or administrative hearing pertaining to Dog, has been declared a dangerous or potentially dangerous dog, or vicious or potentially vicious dog, that has to be muzzled around people, or is a guard dog or protection dog.

I understand that if I am not currently a member of PCOTC that this application is also an application for Associate Membership (no additional fees/forms required). Associate Membership is open to all persons 18 years or older who agree to abide by the Constitution and bylaws of the Port Chester Obedience Training Club and the rules of the AKC. This Agreement is binding upon Client, the spouse of Client, and the children of Client. This Agreement supersedes all prior discussions, representations, warranties and agreements of the parties, and expresses the entire agreement between Client and PCOTC, its Trainers and their agents regarding the matters described above. The parties confirm that, except for that which is specifically written in this Agreement, no promises, representations or oral understandings have been made with regard to Dog or anything else. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, Client acknowledges that neither PCOTC or it's Trainers or agents have represented, promised, guaranteed or warranted that my dog can be trained, that my dog will never bite, that my dog will not be dangerous or vicious in the future, that my dog will not exhibit other behavioral problems, or that the training will last for any particular amount of time. This Agreement may be amended only by a written instrument signed by both Client and the PCOTC board of Directors (not its Trainers and/or their agents). Any remedy provided in this Agreement is in addition to any and all other remedies provided by law or equity. If any provision of this Agreement is invalid, void or unenforceable, they will be severed and the remaining provisions shall be given full force and effect.
